

It could result in children being exposed to lessons that are contrary to Church teaching. We are asked to respond to a consultation to ensure we have our say on this matter. With a deadline of Thursday 23rd November, it is recommended that all paper responses be posted no later than Monday 20th November, while online responses can be submitted up to the closing date.
