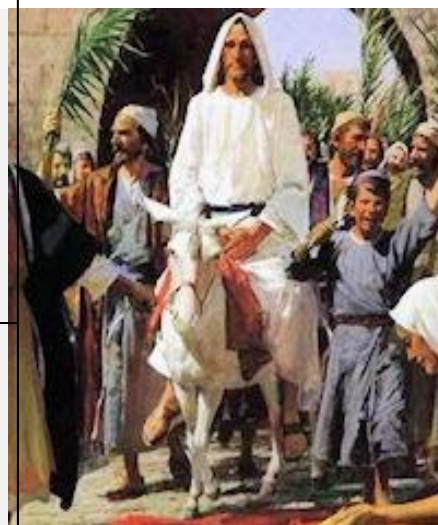

Parishioners are reminded that the Assisted Suicide Bill has been working its way through the Westminster Parliament over the last few months with the upcoming Third Reading vote due on Friday 25th April. As a consequence of opposition by ourselves and others up and down the UK, more MP's have expressed reservations about the bill or might reconsider their positions and vote against it at the third reading. Please take one of the opposition cards: Assist us to live, not to die and send it to your MP with your name, address and postcode. The card will need a standard letter stamp.
