Gospel: Matthew 11: 25-30

Gospel Reflection - The first part of this text is also found in Luke. The second part is unique to Matthew What comforting words! 'Come to me all you who labour and are overburdened and I will give you rest.' The background may lie in Matthew's desire to boost the confidence of a community of Jewish converts to Christianity who have suffered horrendously at the hands of the leadership of their former community. By contrast, Jesus' yoke is easy, his burden light.
