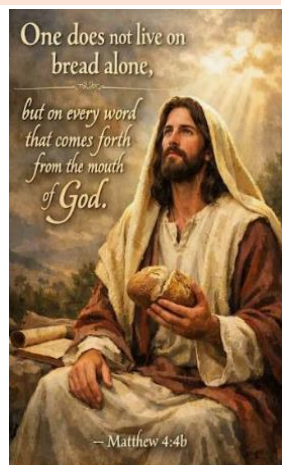
1st Reading: Isaiah 55:1-3

Gospel Reflection – The feeding of the five thousand is the only miracle found in all four gospels. Only Matthew's account refers to 5,000 men, women and children! There is nothing in any of the accounts to support the view that the miracle was really people sharing their food with each other. This miracle is entirely the work of God, performed by Jesus. It recalls how God alone fed the Israelites with manna in the desert.
